LIBRARY SERVICES

View your patron record & renew items at the BPL Home Page (brentwoodnylibrary.org), click on GREEN login button on top right corner of screen

- You will be prompted to type in your barcode (from the back of your library card) and your password. If you do not have a password, just type in your barcode and click submit and you will then be prompted to create one.
- Click on your Currently Checked Out items.
- Renew all items by clicking on Renew All, or check boxes next to selected items and click on Renew Selected Items. A hold on a title by another patron will prevent your renewal.
- You can also change your password, and view outstanding holds and fines.

REQUEST A BOOK OR OTHER MATERIAL

- Go to the BPL Home Page click on search box at the top of the page.
- Enter a search title, author, subject, or word (keyword) in the search box.
- Click on the desired title.
- Click on the Request button.
- When prompted, enter your barcode number and password. Press the Submit button.
- You will receive an email or a phone call when your item is ready for pick-up. If you only want to search for items in the Brentwood catalog, click on a title. On the right hand side of the page click Classic Catalog. When you find what you are looking for, follow the same steps to request the item.

CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER

The Career Development Center is here to provide patrons of the Brentwood Public Library the resources necessary to inform, educate and enrich their lives, specifically to aid post-secondary level patrons in their quest to improve their lives by changing careers or improving their education or both.

LOCAL HISTORY ROOM

The Brentwood Public Library Local History Room is housed in the original second school house building of School District 12. Our collection includes books, periodicals, and files on Brentwood, Long Island, and New York history and genealogy. School yearbooks, historical newspapers, postcards, and photographs are available to view in the library, while our digital collections and databases are accessible both on library computers and from home. Original writings, artwork, and historical items from the Utopian village of Modern Times (which later developed into Brentwood) can be found in our archive and on exhibit. The library newsletter includes a listing of informational programs on history, historical arts and crafts, and genealogy programs offered by the local history department.

Policies

LIBRARY CARD USE

For your own convenience and security, please always present your library card at Circulation when checking out. Proper identification is required if you do not have your library card with you. A card is required for check-out at any time when our circulation system is offline.

LOST LIBRARY CARDS

There is a \$1.00 replacement fee for a lost library card.



RESERVES

Reserves may be placed in person, on the phone or online. There is a limit of reserves per library card. You will be contacted through e-mail or by phone depending on how you have set up the account, when your materials are ready for pick up.

RENEWALS

Materials may be renewed unless they are on reserve for another patron. Items may be renewed in person, by telephone with your barcode or online. *Materials on loan from other libraries may only be renewed if the lending library agrees. *To utilize our online services, please visit our web page and log into your account. Overdue materials will not renew online.

INTERLIBRARY LOANS

Patrons who want to borrow materials from other libraries can request materials through interlibrary loan. Loan requests can be made in person, by phone or online.

LOAN PERIOD/FINES

If you accumulate \$25.00 or more in fines on your card, you will be unable to check out materials until pay 10% towards your fine at each checkout. These policies replace all previous policies relating to library cards, loan periods, reserves, renewals, fines and lost materials.






