NYS REQUIRES ALL MOTORIZED VESSEL OPERATORS, REGARDLESS OF AGE, TO HOLD A BOATER SAFETY CERTIFICATION BY JANUARY 1, 2025.

All boaters born on or after January 1, 1978 certification required by 2024.

Personal Watercraft operators 14 years of age and older must have a Boater Safety Certificate.

After completion of one eight hour class and passing the written test, the certificate obtained will last a lifetime and meets the NYS Safe Boater Certificate requirements. Please bring drinks, a bag lunch, pen and pencil. Individuals between the ages of 14-16 must be accompanied by an adult.
